All proceeds go toward VocalEye programs that make arts and culture more accessible for people who are blind and partially sighted.

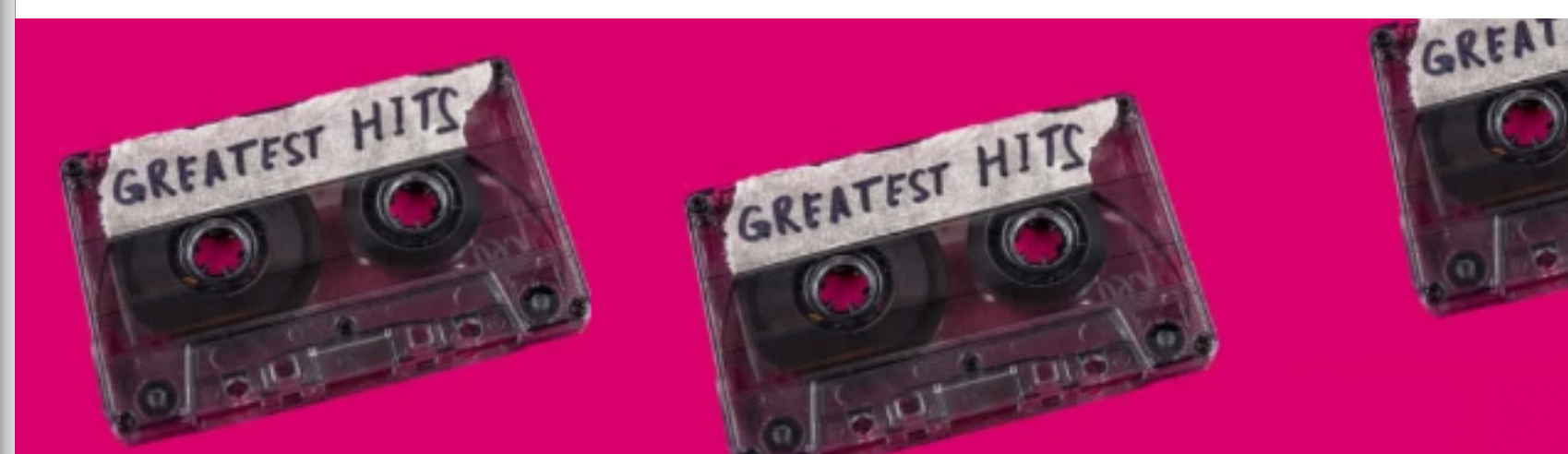
