Hello Friends! We want to start off by saying a humongous thank you to new members of the VocalEye Make it Monthly donor team: Reid, Maria and Kristy (and a shout out to our entire monthly donor team: Amy, Linda H, Linda W, Bill, Richard, Andrew, Steph)! All of our donors and supporters, (no matter what form of support you are offering), really do make all the difference!

VocalEye has recently been in the tough position of scaling back on programming due to cuts in government funding. In order to conserve resources, we are making a slight change to our Almost Live programming. Beginning in April, we're introducing a "Half Time" schedule, which means cutting back to two Almost Live events per month, every other Wednesday. We're also introducing a new "Lite Nites" series! Lite Nites will feature an accessible audio play or audio described film with no guests and no recording - just the presentation with some social time with Amy and fellow community members before and after the show. To keep things easy, the event schedule will remain the same for all events: virtual lobby opens at 6:30 pm and the feature begins at 7 pm Pacific Time. Zoom link and reminder will be sent on the day of the event.

Slight change to e-news schedule: Instead of a monthly Zoom Bulletin, you will receive a short email announcing what's coming up online that week. We will start this new schedule on Monday, April 8, so watch for those details!
